After much searching of the journals of both houses, I have been able to locate two resolutions relating the ratification of the 14th amendment, AJR 11 and SJR 35 – both from the 1867-1868 session. I have enclosed copies of both these resolutions along with the relevant pages of the Senate Journal 1867-1868 session which pertain to SJR 35. (You have already received copies from the Assembly Journal relating to AJR11.) It appears that the two resolutions were opposites – one in favor of ratification and other against and that neither resolution made it out of its own house. 🗨️
